Many apologies for not writing and getting the newletter out to you sooner. So much has been going on that we are struggling to keep up!

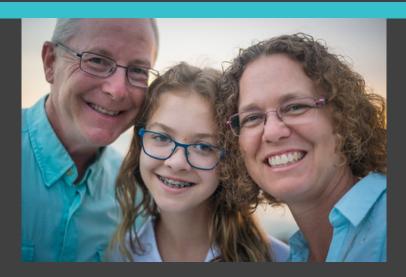
Here are the highlights with more details below:

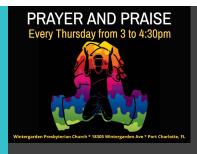

# Fourth Friday Family Fun Night

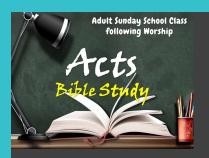
