aligns with this initiative. There are 3 different focuses for being a Matthew 25 congregation and the denomination is asking us to focus in 1...yet, we realized that all 3 are interconnected with the other. So we are working towards living into all three of these focuses.

- Building congregational vitality by challenging people and congregations to deepen their faith and get actively and joyfully engaged with their community and the world.
- Dismantling structural racism by advocating and acting to break down the systems, practices and thinking that underlie discrimination, bias, prejudice and oppression of people of color.
- Eradicating systemic poverty by working to change laws, policies, plans and structures in our society that perpetuate economic exploitation of people who are poor.

With that, we want to embrace that February is Black History Month. The denominations' website shares this information (and much more) on Black History Month.

"Black History Month began in 1926 when Carter G. Woodson started Negro History Week. Woodson had a master's degree from the University of Chicago and a Ph.D. from Harvard University, both in history. As a historian and school principal, he lived experiences that demonstrated to him that Black people were underrepresented in the books and scholarly communication that had shaped American history. The few Black people that were included in such publications were barely mentioned by teachers."

Weekly Communion at Sacred Space Meditation
First Sunday of the Month at the
Traditional Service

We will be using the all-in-one juice and wafer. For folks who are gathering from home please join us by having bread and juice for the service.



In Lent, we're reminded that, again and again, suffering and brokenness find us. We doubt again, we lament again, we mess up again. Again and again, the story of Jesus on the cross repeats-every time lives, are taken unjustly, every time the powerful choose corruption and violence, every time individuals forget how to love. With exacerbation we exclaim, "Again?! How long, O God?" And yet, in the midst of the motion blur chaos of our lives, God offers a sacred refrain: "I choosey, I love you, I will lead you to repair." Again and again, God breaks the cycle and offers us a new way forward.

This theme provides a clear invitation in a time when much is unclear. Even if worshiping apart, we come to God again and again with our prayers, our dreams, our hopes, and our doubts. Even if from a distance, we will continue to be community to one another—especially when it's hard—by choosing each other over and over again. We will continue to love God with the same persistence God chooses and claims us. Our sub-theme, A Lenten Refrain, speaks to the ways God can make music of our lives. "Refrain" also reminds us that Lent is a

In this season, we need rituals—both old and new—to remember and be transformed. Embodied practice builds muscle memory. Repetition helps retrain our neural pathways. We need the 46 days of Lent because this season shapes us into more faithful disciples. Join us this Lent as again and again, we bring all of who we are to God and trust that God will meet us, time and again, along the way.

Join us as we begin this journey on Wednesday, February 17 at 12pm for our Ash Wednesday service in the Memorial Garden. We will continue this journey through Easter Sunday on Sunday, April 4th.



Lectio Divina, literally meaning "divine reading," is an ancient practice of praying the Scriptures. During Lectio Divina, the person listens to the text of the Bible with the "ear of the heart," as if he or she is in conversation with God, and God is suggesting the topics for discussion.

There are four movements for Lectio Divina:

- 1. Lectio: (Listening to the Word of God or Reading God's Word)
  - 2. Meditatio: (Reflecting on the Word of God)
  - 3. Oratio: (Responding to the Word of God)
  - 4. Contemplatio: (Resting in the Word of God)

During Lent, we will gather via zoom for an intentional time of listening, reflecting, responding, and resting in the Word of God. We will meet on Mondays during Lent 8-9am beginning Monday, February
