
Adult Sunday School - Sundays @ 10:45am

Fellowship has been a time for conversation, catching up, and praying. We hope more folks will be able to join us during the week.



Lectio Divina, literally meaning "divine reading," is an ancient practice of praying the Scriptures. During Lectio Divina, the person listens to the text of the Bible with the "ear of the heart," as if he or she is in conversation with God, and God is suggesting the topics for discussion.

All are welcome to join us every Monday morning at 8am to study the scripture that will be used for worship the following Sunday.

There are four movements for Lectio Divina:

- 1. Lectio: (Listening to the Word of God or Reading God's Word)
 - 2. Meditatio: (Reflecting on the Word of God)
 - 3. Oratio: (Responding to the Word of God)
 - 4. Contemplatio: (Resting in the Word of God)
